
Personal Project User Journey Map



Scenario

The user begins the process by first opening up the web app. Working under the assumption that it is their first time visiting the site, they are prompted to create an account. This requires information such as their full name and email, along with their requested username and password. Once completed, the user will then be prompted to build their bio, where they can select the various restrictions they may want to include in future searches. There will be an extensive list of options to choose from, and users will not be limited to any certain number of selections.

When the user goes to complete a new search, they will have the option to include all of the restrictions from their saved account, and can also manually add or remove restrictions to customize the search to their liking. By being able to add additional restrictions, users can then include the restrictions of friends and family. The user then submits their search.

Once the search paramters are submitted, restaurants results will then be displayed. On the display page, a map will be visible resembling Google Maps UI to indicate the locations of the results. Additionally, a list will also be visible dispalying the same results as the map, where users can scroll and browse through each option. Users have the ability to view more details about a given restaurant by selecting into it from the list.

Once a restaurant is clicked into, various details will be displayed. This includes, but is not limited to, the address, name, phone number, along with specific menu items that adhere to their search specifications. There will also be a reviews section that the user can read. This will contain reviews submitted by other customers on the app. This allows users to see how other found their experience to be with a given restaurant. Once a user has browesed through their options, they will be properly equipped to make a final selection and can contact the restaurant!
